- Be in their final year of medical studies
- Be in good academic and professional standing
- Have taken and passed the USMLE Step 1 exam or COMLEX-USA Level 1 exam
- Have taken and passed their required M3 rotations in Internal Medicine, Obstetrics/Gynecology,
 Pediatrics and Surgery BEFORE their elective here begins
- Have completed 48 weeks of required rotations in the same medical school where they completed their basic science (M1 and M2) training
- Apply using VSAS, AAMC's Visiting Student Application Service; no applications are accepted outside
 of VSAS (unless you are from Ascension-Providence's list of affiliated medical schools)

- <u>Immunization form:</u> AAMC Standard Immunization Form completed and signed by a licensed health care provider. Uploaded by applicant.
- Personal Statement (see above): PDF or MS Word file only; limit one page.
- Photograph: A current photo of yourself.
- Transcript: PDF only. Your current medical school transcript. NOTE: Uploaded by your home institution.
- <u>Score Report(s):</u> PDF only; no page limit. Visiting student applicants must have taken and passed the USMLE Step 1 exam and/or the COMLEX-USA Level 1 exam prior to applying. Uploaded by applicant.

The elective's approval is under the ultimate direction and control of the neurosurgery program director.

ROTATING OFF-CYCLE IS NOT PERMITTED: You must rotate according to the 4-week rotation dates indicated on the 2019-20 Visiting Student Calendar. If your home institution's academic calendar does not align with ours, please inquire with your home institution whether an approved vacation or leave can be obtained.

AN OFFER IS VALID ONLY IF IT IS MADE VIA VSAS (unless you are from an affiliated school): If a visiting student wishes to receive credit for an elective, then the official offer of a visiting rotation needs to be generated by our office using VSAS. Arrangements made outside of our office and VSAS are not valid and will result in a student not being enrolled.

UPON BEING EXTENDED AN OFFER, you have one week from the date of notification to accept or decline the offer in VSAS. If no response is received by 8:00 PM EST on the expiration date, the offer will expire in VSAS and will no longer be valid. NOTE: Completing a rotation at Ascension-Providence does not guarantee an interview for residency.
